## 5.0 ENVIRONMENTAL CRITERIA

### 5.1 Legal Requirements

The products listed above meet the provisions of all relevant laws and regulations that apply during their life cycle.

### 5.2 Fibre Source

All virgin fibre in the sanitary paper products is from legally harvested sources.

Any native forest used as a source of virgin fibre input are licensed under the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) as sustainably managed (or equivalent certification).

The fibre source is 100% recycled content with at least 50% post consumer content. √  
(as relevant)

The fibre source is 100% from sawdust/ wood chips and /or waste wood from wood processing operations, forest harvesting waste (including thinnings) and/or untreated demolition and/or recycled fibrewaste wood sources. √

For virgin fibre products, at least 50% of the fibre is from plantations or forests licensed under the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) as sustainably managed (or equivalent certification). √

For mixed fibre products, at least 90% of the total fibre is recycled content, waste wood or FSC licensed (or equivalent) virgin fibre.

A procurement programme is in place which aims to maximise, as relevant, the post consumer component of recycled content, the percentage of virgin fibre that is FSC (or equivalent) licensed, and/or the total percentage of fibre that is recycled, waste wood and FSC (or equivalent) licensed (in that order of preference) in mixed fibre products.

### 5.3 Hazardous Substances

Chlorine gas is not used as a bleaching agent.

Ethylenediamine tetraacetic acid (EDTA) is not used.

Dyes, pigments or coating which have the following ratings (or equivalent ratings from national or international schemes) are not used:

- R40 (limited evidence of carcinogenic effect)
- R43 (may cause sensitisation by skin contact)
- R45 (may cause cancer)
- R46 (may cause heritable genetic damage)
- R49 (may cause cancer by inhalation)
- R50 (very toxic to aquatic organisms)
- R51 (toxic to aquatic organisms)
