It is important to preserve some of these rivers in their natural state so that (1) native species may survive (2) some introduced species such as trout, are provided with ideal habitat, (3) sporting opportunities such as fishing, rafting, canoeing etc are left with untouched waterways to enjoy (4) the natural scenic beauty is preserved & (5) species of birds, insect life etc which uses the riverbed <sup>or banks</sup> as habitat, are preserved.

I seek the following decision from the special tribunal:


