Dear Neighbour

Last week we were horrified to find that the Turitea Windfarm, initially just planned to go along the Tararua ridgeline, is to extend to Bryant Hill, where a group of 125 metre turbines will be 1200 to 1700 metres from all of us. From our reading of all the experiences available, this is far too close to a community for many reasons, and much closer than any other windfarm. We are mainly concerned about health impacts, as there are now many medically documented cases of constant vibration and noise causing sleep deprivation, disorientation and inability to concentrate directly attributable to turbines not as close as those planned to us.

Since learning of the final plans we have been trying to understand the planning process by talking to officials, attending meetings and reading lots. One thing is very clear - if every single one of us objects at the RMA hearing to consider the current plans, we have a good chance of preventing this cluster of turbines being erected.

We have taken up the task of informing our neighbourhood of the situation and would like to keep in touch as the windfarm planning process proceeds. We urge you to read as much as you can on the potential threats to our health and lifestyle. There is no time to waste - Mighty River Power will most likely lodge their resource consent in August.

We've included a map that shows how close the turbines will be to your property. There also is a lot of information on the internet - some of the more significant sites are listed below.
