NOTICE OF APPEAL TO ENVIRONMENT COURT (general)

I, Andrew Edward Day, appeal against a decision on the following matter:

The proposed Te Rere Hau Wind Farm Eastern Extension by New Zealand Windfarms.

I received notice of the decision on 6th February 2010 (letter dated 4th, attached).

The decision was made by the Tararua District Council and the Manawatu-Wanganui Regional Council

The decision (or part of the decision) that I am appealing is: not to include secondary noise limits in Appendix 1 in the notice of decision.

The reasons for the appeal are as follows:

I believe that differential wind conditions do exist between my residence and the wind farm site which do justify consideration of secondary noise limits given the tonal nature of the turbines and the cumulative noise from existing similar turbines.

I seek the following relief:

The conclusions set out in appendix 3 of the Notice of Decision are carried out and that permanent wind speed and suitable acoustic monitoring equipment is installed in the vicinity of my residence once the wind farm is constructed.

I'm amenable to mediation if it can help resolve these issues and not unduly delay the construction of the project (I'm certainly not against the project in its entirety and recognize the terrific resource available that should be utilized).
