

I oppose comments relating to Objective 2 – ensuring intergrated management to effects on water. Councils advises current management is adequate and is not convinced the apparent lack of integration is resulting in water degradation. They are concerned that if Dairy Conversions become an item for consent, then the cost and time involved in administering the change is too costly.

More dramatically however, the Council anticipates up to “ 100 additional dairy conversions per annum for the next 5 years “. These figures are staggering. If the Southland District Council can project these figures, what is the total for all of New Zealand.

These projections of land use change on such a scale are exactly the reason why the Government must act immediately to protect our fresh water resources. The variance in mindset between Councils in areas like Waikato & Taranaki Who are now trying to remedy problems caused by 30 odd years of intensive dairy activity, and Councils that are just starting to enjoy the early flush of revenue from A relatively new local industry, is all too apparent in the reading of these publicly advertised submissions.

The conclusions justifies Government insistence that National Guidelines be put in place.

I wish to advise my disagreements with the findings of the Southland District Council in this matter.
