


# Your submission to Clean Water

**Clause**

What are your thoughts on the proposed swimming targets, for example, on the timeframes and categories?

**Notes**

The Swimming targets are not good enough, we should be aiming for all water to be swimmable, Not Wadeable but swimmable. Continuously moving the goalposts is appalling behaviour from the very people who should be protecting the waterways that belong to all New Zealanders and future generations.

**Clause**

What do you think about the proposed amendments to the Freshwater NPS?

**Notes**
