A climate law like the Zero Carbon Act is important because...	at a time when the most rapid change in the environment is taking place on our planet, compounded by the human factor, who now number greater populations globally than ever before, dynamic change in our attitude is urgently needed in the treatment of this planet we call home. Adaptation	I support a plan for adaptation being included in the Zero Carbon Act.
Climate justice	A Zero Carbon Act must be just and fair in that it honours Te Tiriti o Waitangi; ensures a just transition for workers and communities; and avoids passing on the costs to future generations.
