A climate law like the Zero Carbon Act is important because...	<p>I support the most ambitious target of reducing total greenhouse gases to net zero by 2050.</p> <p>I also support taking a science-based approach to ensure our efforts to reduce emissions have as much impact in reducing greenhouse gases as soon as possible.
