

As a visiting angler from England, I wish to record my view that all New Zealand freshwaters should be swimmable, fishable and safe for food gathering and that the National Objectives Framework should include measurable parameters that directly relate to these values. This should ensure that limits for potentially polluting substances are set correctly so as to protect inland waterways, rivers and lakes to be habitable to trout and salmon and safe for fishing and eating any fish that may be fish taken.
