The government's [own discussion document](#) admits the current scheme is so weak that it does nothing to reduce emissions. It urgently needs to be fixed!

The ETS needs to be changed so that companies pay for the greenhouse gas emissions they create.

This includes, at the very least, ending the one unit for two tonnes of emissions arrangement as soon as possible and ensuring the trading of international emissions units does not undermine the emissions price in New Zealand.

The ETS is just one of many policies the government should implement to combat climate change. The point of the ETS is to create a meaningful price on emissions that helps, alongside other policies, drive changes in business and individual behaviour.
