Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to offer my opinion to the ETS consultation. I feel that on behalf of future generations we need to act now on greenhouse gases (GHG) emissions and the current ETS is not fit for purpose.

1. Replacing the 97m fraudulent credits we have handed over to honour international commitments with bona fide ones;
2. Limit future trade in international credits to a finite percentage of units surrendered under the Emissions Trading Scheme
3. Set domestic emissions reduction targets
4. Develop a plan to meet those emissions reduction targets
5. Use tools other than the ETS to achieve those targets
6. Ideally the targets, plan, tools and monitoring should be overseen by an independent Committee reporting to Parliament as per the UK Climate Change Act.
